

Call for abstracts

The organizers of the 2010 North Carolina Nanotechnology Commercialization Conference, in conjunction with the UNC-Charlotte Association of Nanoscience Graduate Students, announce a call for abstracts for a student poster session. The conference will be held March 31-April 1 in the Koury Convention Center in Greensboro, NC. Posters highlighting original student research in the fields of nanoscience and nanotechnology will be accepted. It is encouraged that a significant section of the poster address implementation of the research presented in commercial products. Posters are to be presented during the evening cocktail reception on the evening of March 31st from 5:00 to 6:30. During this time a review panel will be judging the posters.

Poster winners will be announced and prizes awarded during the conference closing session at 5:00 pm April 1st.

Students will be permitted to register for the conference at a reduced rate of \$50.

A concise abstract (no more than 250 words) is required for all posters to be presented.

The deadline for abstract submission is February 26, 2010 at 5 pm.

Please email abstracts as a Microsoft Word (.doc, .docx) file to kmajor@uncc.edu. Include the name, email address, and institution of the presenter at the top of the page, before the title.

Applicants will be notified of their acceptance by March 5, 2010. At this point specific requirements relating to poster size and other details will be provided.

Cover Image Competition

In addition to the poster competition, the organizers also announce a separate image competition for use on conference materials. These images can be microscopy, circuit diagrams, photographs, etc. All submitted images should include a brief (2-3 sentence) description. The winning image(s) will be used in all publicity materials for the conference, winner will be recognized at the conference and can potentially take home a poster featuring their image, and will get free conference registration.
